TOURNAMENT RULES

The Tauranga Classic is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Senior Men and Senior Ladies entrants must attain the age of 50 or above in 2019.

Bowlers may compete in one division only.

The number of available spots may be adjusted after Sunday 3rd February 2019 if one or more divisions has less than the maximum listed and the division scheduled to bowl at the same time on Sunday has a waiting list.

Tauranga Classic has a minimum age requirement of 16 January 1st 2019

No smoking or consumption of alcohol is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.

Each competitor will bowl 8 games (in blocks of 2) on Saturday and 8 games (in blocks of 2) on Sunday. The lane draw will be random. The number of lanes moved after each block, assuming full squads, will be six lanes.

Saturday 9th February Lane Pattern Kegel Challenge Series Taj Mahal (adjusted to 30ml) 38 feet.

Sunday 10th February Lane Pattern Kegel Challenge Series Statue of Liberty (adjusted to 30 ml) 47 feet.

Final placing will be decided on total pinfall. Should a tie occur for 1st place, a one game playoff will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placing the prize money will be split.

Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any moneys paid. The Tournament Committee may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate.

All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This includes either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Ladies may wear skirts, dress trousers, or shorts. Track pants, cargo pants or any denim material are not permitted.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Committee within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.

Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision will be final.
