TOURNAMENT RULES

The Harcourts Youth Cup is a scratch event open to all current TBNZ registered players. Youth entrants must be under the age of 21 prior to 01st January 2021.

1. Bowlers may compete in one division only.
2. No smoking or consumption of alcohol is not permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play in your squad on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.
3. Each competitor will bowl 8 games (blocks of 2) on Sat and 8 games (in blocks of 2) on Sun. The lane draw will be random.
4. Final placing will be decided on total pinfall. If a tie occurs for 1st place in any division, a 1 game roll off will take place to determine the winner. If a tie occurs in any other placing, the prize money will be shared.
5. The number of lanes moved after each block of 2 games, will be 4 lanes.
6. Any bowler who fails to meet check-in time (as per the centre clock) will be disqualified, without refund of any monies paid. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate.
7. All competitors are required to have a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a collared shirt or a bowling company branded shirt. Men must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Women must wear skirts, dress trousers, or dress shorts. Track pants, cargo pants, or any denim material are not permitted.
8. All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within seven days prior to the tournament.
9. Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the block of play concerned.
10. Any matters not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
